It doesn't look as if it's going to be business as usual at St Kenelm's Church for some time yet. The Parochial Church Council is reviewing its options for some kind of opening of the church but the regulations and guidelines governing what can be done are formidable, reasonably enough. In particular, it looks really difficult to have unrestricted access to the church during the day, as pre-Covid, because managing the health threat to and from visitors would be next to impossible for a congregation —many of whose members are not allowed to be part of that management.

On the other hand, the PCC understands that the community is entitled to the use of its Parish Church in so far as that use can be made safe. It may be possible to open the church for weddings, funerals and baptisms, provided that a sufficient number of people able and willing to manage such occasions can be enlisted. Whether the PCC will feel that the benefits of regular Sunday worship would outweigh the risks and the difficulties involved is uncertain, to say the least. The services might well feel rather awkward and impoverished – social distancing, no congregational singing, no coffee afterwards. It may be that the Zoom services organised for Witney Benefice as a whole offer a better way of worshipping just now – certainly, one of the positive surprises of the Covid situation is how well Zoom has worked for so many people previously unaware of the medium, and not least for church congregations.

All the best to everyone in dealing with a changing but still very difficult situation and please do be in touch if you think we might be able to help. It's perhaps worth reminding the village that the St Kenelm's Trust makes available to under-25s bursaries for educational purposes.



Minster Lovell Parish Council

With a slight ease in lockdown measures at the time of writing, the Parish Council hopes that you are all staying well and have been able to spend more time with friends and loved ones at this difficult time, and have been able to enjoy the warm summer days in our beautiful part of the world.

Ripley Avenue

The Council has commissioned work to replace and move the football goals in the Amenity Area to provide children in the Village with a much-needed outlet for energy over the summer months. The Council asks that parents ensure that children take care of the new football goals to prevent damage and ensure that they are available for all children to use.

The Council discussed opening the Ripley Avenue play park at the July Parish Council meeting but have reluctantly agreed that it is not possible to follow the Government guidance on managing the park safely. The Council will review this again at the August meeting.

Please remember to keep your dog on a lead when you are in the Amenity Area and do not let dogs run free. The Council has recently responded to a request from a resident to remove a bench to deter young people congregating and causing a nuisance in the evenings.

Village maintenance

The Clerk has reported several maintenance issues in the Village to OCC and WODC recently, including overgrown hedges and broken and rusting bins. Please contact the Clerk if you spot anything which needs attending to in the Village during the summer months. The full and over-flowing litter bins are reported to WODC almost on a daily basis and the Council will review the collection schedule. If more collections are required this will of course be at a cost to the Parish Council.

The Council recently selected a contractor to carry out weedkilling in the village, which has now taken place for this year. The Council will shortly be commissioning a contractor to carry out the bi-annual survey of all Councilowned trees.

The Council is currently exploring the possibility of installing a handrail at the end of the stile on the footpath to School Hill and will discuss this further at the July Parish Council meeting. The seat opposite Bridge Cottage has also been removed for repair.

The Council also plans to set up an annual review schedule for next year, with regular inspections of benches and open areas of the Village, and a dedicated fund for carrying out repairs and maintenance and purchasing replacements.

New fencing has been installed at the entrance to Wychwood Close which has improved the area and the Council will ensure that area remains in a good condition.

Dog litter

Unfortunately there has been an increase in dog litter in the Village, particularly on the footpath between Minster Lovell and Curbridge. The Council are liaising with West Oxfordshire District Council on the possibility of installing an additional dog litter bin on the footpath but in the meantime

please do dispose of all dog litter in a safe and responsible way. A recent survey showed that the Village has **21** dog litter bins so we are certainly not short of a place to deposit dog litter!

Bridge consultation

Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) recently held a public consultation on restricting the weight of several local bridges, including that in the Lower Village, to 18 tonnes. The Parish Council objected to the consultation and requested that the limit be set at 7.5 tonnes. A representative from the Parish Council joined an OCC meeting to discuss the proposals in July and reported back to the July meeting to confirm that a 7.5 tonnes limit will be put in place on Burford Road and Brize Norton Road.

Parking in the Old Village

The Parish Council has received several complaints from residents of the Old Village regarding visitors to the area parking unsafely and inconsiderately. The Council has previously raised this issue with OCC and the local Police will continue to pursue this directly with them. Although the Council is sympathetic of the problem, unfortunately the Parish Council itself is not able to do anything to prevent parking. If cars are parked unsafely or causing an obstruction please contact the Police on 101 to report the issue.

Audit

The Parish Council has received a pre-audit report and will be discussing the recommendations from this at the July Parish Council meeting. The Clerk will advertise the period for the public to exercise their right to view the accounts on the Parish Council website and village noticeboards.
